Elementary educator certification must include one endorsement area from the approved list of endorsements offered by Idaho State University.

Secondary educator certification (grades 6-12) must have either:

- Single-subject (45 credit) endorsement
- OR**
- A 30 credit and 20 credit combination of endorsement areas

Natural science requires a second endorsement in either biology, chemistry, physics, or geology/earth science.

Social Studies requires a second endorsement in either History or American Government
