Position: **Assistant Lecturer of Mathematics (non tenure-track)**
9-Month, Full-Time

THE OPPORTUNITY: The Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Idaho State University invites applications for a lecturer position (non-tenure track) at the rank of assistant lecturer, to begin 18 August 2025.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The key responsibilities of this position are to teach intermediate level mathematics courses, online courses and/or other lower-division courses (approximately 13 credits/semester), and to provide service to the department, the college, the university, and the community (approximately 2 workload units per semester).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: ● Master's Degree in Mathematics or a closely related area (must be completed prior to the start date). ● Experience with teaching one or more of the following: intermediate-level mathematics courses; online courses; corequisite introductory courses.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: ● Experience with or demonstrated potential to teach intermediate-level mathematics courses. ● Experience with or demonstrated potential to teach online courses in asynchronous, synchronous, and/or HyFlex format. ● Experience with or demonstrated potential to teach corequisite introductory courses. ● Experience with various classroom instructional strategies, such as collaborative/active learning, that engage students in the learning process. ● Ability to work with or experience working with students, faculty, and staff from diverse backgrounds. ● Effective written and oral communication skills, and ability to work in a team environment.

HOW TO APPLY: The application must include: 1. A cover letter stating interest and qualifications for the position, 2. A current curriculum vitae, 3. Unofficial undergraduate and graduate transcripts, 4. A teaching philosophy statement of at most two pages, 5. Three current letters of reference. At least two letters should address teaching ability.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: At this time, ISU cannot provide visa sponsorships.

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics is experiencing multiple retirements, resulting in new hires to replace several of our lecturer lines and tenure-lines over the span of a few years. The department maintains a highly trained and research-active faculty with a balanced commitment to teaching, research, and service, that conducts research in pure and applied mathematics and statistics. The department offers degrees in Mathematics, Applied Mathematics, and Statistics, mirroring the core specializations of our faculty. The department provides courses in mathematics and

statistics that serve students in science and engineering, education, health professions, and business. A small student-to-faculty ratio affords close interaction with students. The main campus of Idaho State University is nestled among the mountains of Eastern Idaho. Pocatello is the last undiscovered college mountain town in the west, located within 2.5 hours of Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, as well as Salt Lake City. Only a few minutes from campus, you can find world-class outdoor activities. Regional airports are located in Pocatello and nearby Idaho Falls, and collaborative research opportunities and student internships abound at the Idaho National Laboratory in Idaho Falls.

Salary will be commensurate with education and experience. All offers of employment are conditional pending the successful completion of a background investigation, provided by HireRight.
