

Surveying and Geomatics Engineering Technology

Career Path Internship (CPI) Program - *Qualification for Eligibility:*

1. Student must be a major in Surveying and Geomatics Engineering Technology
2. Good academic standing.
3. Full time student (12 or more credits)
4. Department will pay up to 20 hours/week as funding allows.
5. Student is limited to 20 hours/week.
6. Students are encouraged to hold off-campus CPIs within the State of Idaho as long as they are a current ISU student and have approval from their faculty advisor, department chair and respective dean.
7. Dates of employment and hours worked will be coordinated with the employer and department chair.
8. CPI positions may be competitive in nature, and may require additional criteria such as submitting a resume and/or being interviewed.

***No student may begin working as a CPI until ALL forms, including the I-9, have been submitted, approved, and fully processed by the Career Center and Human Resources.**
