 Admission Criteria

Minimum Requirements:

- Completion of the following prerequisite courses or equivalent with a grade of “C” HO 0111 **OR** BIOL 2227/2227L **and** BIOL 2228/2228L **OR** BIOL 3302/3302L **and** BIOL 3301/3301L and BIOL 3302/3302L; LLIB 1115: ENGL 1101 or equivalent.
- A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 is required.
- Current Certified Nursing Assistant card **OR** JST verification of medic/corpsman
- On-line Dosage Calculation Math Course from Workforce Training.
- Current CPR certification (Healthcare Provider) from the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross.
- Current immunization and good health status per program policy, upon conditional acceptance into the program.
- Background check and drug screening per department policy, upon acceptance into the program.

***After meeting the minimum requirements above, students are ranked based on the point system as follows:**
