If you are a student returning to the IEI or delaying your anticipated start date, new financial documentation will be necessary if your earlier financial documentation is older than six months. ISU has calculated the following official yearly estimates of expenses to study at the IEI. These are only estimates and may not include all costs for all situations. These estimates do not include the cost of optional fees or extra course-specific fees.
