CORE COMPETENCY THRESHOLD POLICY

Medical Laboratory Scientists are a critical part of the health care team. 70% or more of all diagnostic decisions are made from laboratory results. The results and information you supply physicians or primary care providers has a dramatic impact on patient care. Poor quality work, misinformation, misdiagnosis, or lack of underlying didactic knowledge can have serious negative implications on patient care, perhaps even leading to patient death. As such, the Medical Laboratory Sciences program at Idaho State University has determined Core Competency Thresholds for certain assignments that are critical for all MLS students.

Students must pass all Core Competency Threshold assignments with a minimum grade of 65% or better. Failure to meet this expectation will result in **automatic failure (GRADE OF F)** in the corresponding MLS course, **regardless of the total point accumulation in that class**. Please refer to the Medical Laboratory Science Student Handbook Policy for consequences of failing any MLS course.
