

Portneuf Range Yurt System

The Portneuf Range Yurt System consists of a series of four winter huts located in southeast Idaho. Users should realize that winter travel and the use of the yurts have inherent risks. The Outdoor Adventure Center maintains the yurt system, but because of the possibility of extreme weather, vandalism, and other problems, **we cannot guarantee the condition of the yurts** and their contents. Besides the yurt itself, there are plenty of other problems that you and your party can encounter in the harsh and unforgiving winter environment. Before going on a yurt tour, discuss potential problems with your party and **make a careful choice whether you are willing to assume the risks**. Before using any of the yurts, we recommend you or members of your party should take at least **one advance day trip** to the yurt site. If you are uncertain of your route finding skills, go with an organized group that is familiar with the location.

Reservation and Cancellation Policy

Yurt Reservations require a complete payment of fees that are non-refundable. A credit for a future date during that season will be given with a **2 week cancellation notice**. The fees will be applied to a yurt rental of equal or lesser value. If a renter chooses a rental of greater value, additional fees will be collected before the rental is secured. **Those who cancel within the two weeks before their reservation will forfeit their fees.** A reservation and credit transfer will be allowed only once and credit must be used that season. **Please understand that it is the responsibility of the yurt user to locate the yurt. Yurt rental fees will not be refunded if the yurt is not located. The OAC makes no guarantees of weather, snow or avalanche conditions and refunds will not be issued for these conditions.**

Check In/Check Out Time

Reservations begin 2:30 PM the day the yurt is reserved and extend to 2:30 PM the next day.

Doors Locked for Security Reasons:

All doors on the yurts are locked. You will need to get the combination the week before your trip from the Outdoor Adventure Center by calling (208) 282-3912.

You will find Propane Stoves and Lanterns at the Yurt

Yurt renters must provide their own propane cylinders. Please take out used cylinders. These can be recycled at the Outdoor Adventure Center

Winter travel and use of yurts is inherently dangerous. Yurt use is done at your own risk.
