Accepted to the PA Program.

DECEMBER-MAY

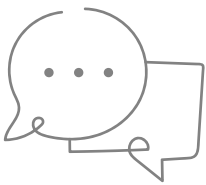
Return your acceptance response letter to the Program's offer, respond to the Graduate School's offer, think about what angle of medicine you're passionate about.



Apply for a health track.

MAY-JULY

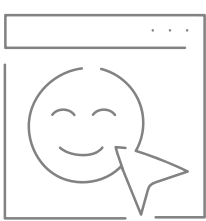
Both the Rural Health Track (RHT) and the Hispanic Health Track (HHT) have internal applications available through the Orientation Moodle.



Interview for your health track.

JUNE-JULY

Both RHT & HHT have internal interviews. Only HHT has a language component to its process.



Apply for AHEC Scholars.

AFTER RHT ACCEPTANCE ONLY

AHEC Scholars has seats reserved for RHT students, so the application is just a formality to get you into the AHEC system. Your acceptance is guaranteed.



Apply for the certificate of your choice.

AFTER TRACK ACCEPTANCE

Both RHT & HHT require you to be pursuing another graduate certificate, which requires a Graduate School application. Choose "Graduate Degree Seeking" > "Certificate".
