



## **Accelerated Nursing Baccalaureate Program: Prerequisite Course Requirements**

### **Set A Prerequisite Courses:**

- A. Set A prerequisite courses must be successfully completed prior to the application deadline. Successful course completion is a grade of “C” or higher.
- B. A minimum combined GPA of 3.0 for all Set A prerequisite courses is required for application eligibility.
- C. Only Set A prerequisite courses are included in the GPA calculation for admission ranking.
- D. Documentation of Set A course completion must be submitted to the School of Nursing Academic Advisor as part of the pre-application process. An unofficial transcript is acceptable.
- E. If courses are taken outside of Idaho State University, official transcripts verifying successful completion must be submitted to the ISU Registrar’s Office as part of the ISU application process.
- F. Petitions to the School of Nursing may be required to establish equivalency for courses taken from other colleges or universities.

## Set B Prerequisite Courses:

- A. Set B prerequisite courses must be successfully completed prior to starting the program in summer semester but not necessarily before application submission.
- B. Successful course completion is with a grade of “C” or higher.
- C. Cumulative GPA for Set A and B courses must be 3.0 or higher.
- D. Verification of completion or current enrollment in Set B prerequisite courses must be submitted at the pre-application advising appointment.
- E. If courses are taken outside of Idaho State University, official transcripts verifying successful completion must be submitted to the ISU Registrar’s Office.
- F. Petitions to the School of Nursing may be required to establish equivalency for courses taken from other universities.
- G. Pathobiology and Pharmacotherapy completed with 3 years of application
